TRACTOR PULL RULES – 1960 AND Prior

General Rules

1. 19-inch drawbar height.
 2. No sign ups after class has started.
 3. Only gasoline, kerosene, or diesel allowed as fuel.
 4. Use of alcoholic beverages before or during pull will result in disqualification.
 5. Front wheels may NOT come more than 18 inches off the ground when pulling.

Rules for Enhanced Class

1. RPM's will be limited to 20% over factory specifications. Each tractor will be checked.
2. No horsepower or tire size limits.
3. End of drawbar must be at least 20 inches behind center of rear axles.
4. Drivers must be 18 years or older.

Entries in this class MAY NOT pull in the Pure Stock Class on Saturday night.

Rules for Pure Stock Class

1. All entries are subject to judge's approval as being stock (carburetor, block, etc.).
 2. No cut tires
 3. Tin wheels allowed
 4. No weights or brackets beyond the front most part of the tractor.
 5. Stock air cleaner must be operational
 6. Must pull in 1st or 2nd gear
 7. End of drawbar must be at least 24 inches behind the center of the rear axles.
 8. Stock RPM's only, each tractor checked.
 9. Driver's 14 to 18 years of age must have parental consent and exhibit adequate driver knowledge to pull.
 10. Top 3 tractors in each class may be dynamometered to determine horsepower.
